



TSCTI wins 5 years Sharepoint IDIQ with The United States Senate

TSCTI teamed up with General Dynamics (GD) which is one of top ten Federal contractors for this opportunity. TSCTI wrote the Sharepoint Integration proposal for US Senate IDIQ and GD is committed to give 35% of the total business from this IDIQ. TSCTI will be providing its Sharepoint technical expertise to US Senate for various task orders. TSCTI & GD team will be involved in design development and deployment of information management systems employing Microsoft SharePoint 2007 for United States Senate Senator and Committee offices.

TSCTI completed Washington State Awards Statewide ITIL Assessment

TSCTI was selected by WA State Department of Information Service (DIS) for ITIL assessment which will include State of Washington's DIS organization's IT Service Management capability including people, processes and ITSM supporting technology/tools used by the DIS organization in December 2009.

TSCTI interviewed senior state management including CIO, and over 20 senior IT managers to conduct an IT Service Management Maturity Assessment to baseline where the DIS processes stand today. The assessment was based on a standard ITIL maturity assessment methodology and utilizes the Capability Maturity Model (CMMi) to provide an industry standard maturity rating scale. TSCTI presented the report and actionable recommendations to improve the overall quality of service to DIS customers.

Project awarded

Sharepoint Architecture Project Award from Superior Court of Orange County.

Under this project, TSCTI will provide technical Services to architect and implement SharePoint portals. TSCTI will work with Court business analyst to understand business needs and requirements and architect the enterprise wide sharepoint implementation.

TSCTI Ventures into Network Architecture with California Prison Healthcare Services.

The California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation (CDCR), California Prison Healthcare Services (CPHCS) has awarded a Network Architect project to TSCTI to provide Support the Unit Health Record Conversion (UHRC) Project. UHCR Network Architect will be analyzing, evaluating and designing CPHCS's Network Architecture and will work under the directions of CPHCS's Deputy Chief Information Officer

TSCTI won yet another SOA Architecture Project with Department of Human and Health Services, State of South Carolina.

TSCTI will be providing leadership and sharing technical acumen for a new MMIS system to be aligned with principles of SOA (Service-Oriented Architecture), the MITA (Medicaid Information Technology Architecture) framework and guide the technical implementation of the SOA strategy. The South

Carolina Department of Health and Human Services has awarded this project to TSCTI to enable success on this high-visibility project.

TSCTI continues its winning pace with State of Texas - Comptroller of Public Accounts (CPA).

TSCTI will create and organize business process flows, related content and user interfaces using Business Process Management in a FileNet environment. In addition, TSCTI will perform analysis of existing business processes to automate them with BPM, conduct reviews of proposed design, test to verify that the development meets the business requirements.

TSCTI won a Consolidated Automation project with Department of Human Services, State of Oregon.

TSCTI will be providing testing services for the Consolidated Automation Project (CAP), a component of the CAF-SSM Program under the overall direction of the CAF-SSM Program Manager. The CAF Self Sufficiency Modernization Program (CAF-SSM) was established by DHS to improve delivery of self sufficiency human services to Oregon citizens in need. This Program will provide online channels for citizen access to benefits and automate workflow for the field service system. These process changes will improve caseworker effectiveness and relieve daily burdens imposed by the current information systems environment and highly manual intensive processes

Oracle Database Development Project

TSCTI's consultant will work on developing several applications using various tools include Oracle 10g DB, Oracle 10g Forms/Report, Oracle Application Express and Oracle JDeveloper to Support the NIMAS Operations. National Institute of Arthritis and Musculoskeletal and Skin Diseases (NIH/NIAMS SITB).

Cold Fusion Development and Maintenance Project

TSCTI's consultants are involved in Designing and Developing websites using CommonSpot, Coldfusion-based Content Management Software using MS SQL Server as the primary RDBMS, assisting in the planning and development of an enhanced user interface (along with improvements to existing applications). They will also be maintaining web monitoring services by developing a Coldfusion-based tracking application implementing Web-Trends and other software for site analysis and reporting.
